Mitigation options, issues and barriers by sector

June, 2016

The first webinar provides an overview of the key steps to conduct a mitigation assessment and translate it into a detailed national climate action plan. It aims at enabling participants to obtain a broad but sound understanding of the process.

 Identification of stakeholders, definition of the scope of the assessment, mitigation assessment timeframes, selection of assessment methodologies (marginal abatement cost curves/economic analysis, modelling), baseline scenarios, and screening of potential mitigation options are among the topics that will be discussed.

The **second webinar** will highlight key mitgation challenges and barriers faced in the sectors of energy supply (electricity generation); transport; buildings; industry; agriculture; forestry and waste management and how these are considereded in a mitigation assessment.

Mitigation technologies that affect multiple sectors, or that cannot be attributed to any particular sector will also be discussed.

*The Consultative Group of Experts on National Communications from Parties not included in Annex I to the Convention (CGE) has the objective of improving the process of preparation of national communications and the Biennial Update Reports (BURs) from non-Annex I Parties.





The **third webinar** will introduce different approaches for GHG mitigation assessment, including: reviewing the benefits and drawbacks of different approaches; and an overview of software modelling tools that may be useful for GHG mitigation analysis, thereby assisting participants when choosing an appropriate tool for their own assessment.
