- Papers should be written in English.
- The paper should be original and has never been published. It should be based on research results development or a review on various aspects of livestock production and veterinary sciences.
- Primary scientific paper should consist of:

1. Title (capital letters)
2. Names and addresses and email addresses of the authors
3. Abstract
4. Introduction should consist of background and aims of research
5. Materials and methods
6. Results and Discussion
7. Conclusion
8. References (80% should be published after year 2000)

- Review paper should consist of :

1. Title (capital letters)
2. Names and addresses and email addresses of the authors
3. Abstract
4. Introduction should consist of background and aims of the review
5. Main Discussion
6. Conclusion
7. References (majority should be published after year 2000)

Maximum length is 10 pages including tables, graphs and figures; Paper size A4 (left border 3 cm, right border 2.5cm, upper and below 2.5 cm); TimesNew Roman size 12; 1.5 space (Abstract and References single space).

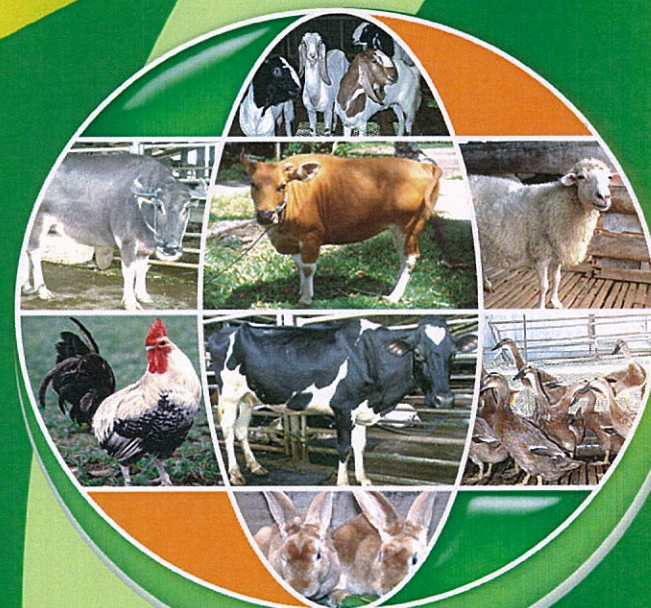
