Regarding the objective of the European commission to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 36% in 2030, the beef sector is developing the 'LIFE BEEF CARBON action plan' aimed at reducing the beef carbon footprint by 15% over 10 years. This plan, which is taking place across four countries producing beef in Europe (France, Ireland, Italy and Spain), is providing livestock farmers and farm advisors with tools and methods to assess carbon footprint at farm level.

The beef carbon footprint is assessed on a sample of 2,000 demonstration farms to create national and European observatories and a network of 170 innovative low carbon farms applying mitigating techniques. By implementing the 'LIFE BEEF CARBON action plan' and reducing the carbon footprint of 2,000 beef farms by 15% over 10 years, partners aim to avoid 120 000 tons of carbon dioxide.

This initiative has been running for two years, so we are inviting you to a conference to share the first results obtained and the dynamics launched in the partners' countries. During this conference, several testimonies will also highlight the contribution of the beef sector to the climate change and stakeholders will present their initiatives developed in this area.
