Update

- Currently, two main streams of research activities related to GHG in croplands
 - AAFC in-house projects
 - Agricultural Greenhouse Gases Program (AGGP) – University-based research
- Both streams are open to international collaboration

Longer-term

- Formation of networks is a welcome evolution of the CRG
 - Canada is co-leading/involved in three networks
 - Conservation Agriculture (C. Drury, AAFC) (co-lead)
 - Agroforestry (R. Farrell, U. of Saskatchewan) (co-lead)
 - Integrated Crop Livestock Systems (M. Chantigny, AAFC)
- Through newly-formed flagship projects, increased collaboration could be achieved with other groups
 - Soil Carbon Sequestration (Integrative Research Group, IRG)
 - Nitrogen Use Efficiency in Soils and Feeds
 - Improved GHG Inventories (IRG)
