# EFS Africa 2019

In order to propose practical solutions from an engineering perspective to achieve SDGs 2 and 12 and establish an operational action plan to improve food security in Africa, an international conference will be hosted by the Tunisian Engineers Order TEO in collaboration with the World Federation of Engineering Organizations WFEO-CEE under the patronage of the Tunisian Government in June 2019 in Tunisia. It will bring together more than 250 engineers, experts in climate change as well as policy makers from various African countries.
