- *Development of the first Tier 2 GHG inventory for the dairy and other cattle (NZAGRC, 2022-2023)*
- *Sensitisation of government and livestock industry players about integration of livestock policy and climate action-NDCs (FAO, 2023- 2024)*
- *Participation in southern Africa regional forums and peer-exchanges under the Africa Climate Action Partnership (SouthSouthNorth, 2023-ongoing)*

Future priorities

- *Capacity building of national coordinating institution on continuous SOPs for GHG inventory compilation (2023)*
- *Collection of country-representative data for animal performance and feed basket (2023-2024)*
- *Extension of the livestock Tier 2 GHG inventory to include small ruminants (2024 - onwards)*
- *Livestock GHG mitigation assessment to inform NDCs (2023 - onwards)*

Capability needs

- *Technical and financial support for improvement of the Tier 2 GHG inventory for dairy and other cattle*
- *Capacity building of government and livestock industry players about livestock policy and climate action-NDCs*
- *Training more local experts about Tier 2 GHG inventory compilation to strengthen institutional capacity*
- *Training local experts about livestock GHG mitigation assessment to inform NDCs (2023 - onwards)*
